Two winning builds will be chosen from the middle and high school categories to be on view in our special exhibition in the Roy Helms Gallery for 2026!



Who: Heritage Village, 11909 125th Street N., Largo, FL 33774, Heritage Village is open Wednesday - Saturday, 10 a.m. - 4 p.m.; Sunday, 1 - 4 p.m. Admission is free, but donations are welcome and benefit Heritage Village operations.

What: LEGO[™]Build Competition for local middle and high school students. Builds must be inspired by or depict historic structures at Heritage Village.

When: Submissions are open from September 1, 2025, until February 10, 2026. The two winning structures from the middle and high school categories will be on display in the special Roy Helms exhibition for 2026. Winning entries will be informed by February 28, 2026.


Why: We aim to engage students with this competition to teach them about Pinellas County history and architecture in our 50th anniversary!

LEGO[™] COMPETITION FALL 2025 RULES

- 1. All creations must be built ahead of time with your own LEGO, DUPLO, or MEGABLOCK bricks, or similar blocks. Heritage Village does not provide the LEGOS and building does not take place on site.
- 2. Entries must be on a solid base for transporting and must not be larger than 24" x 24".
- 3. All entries must depict or be inspired by structures on site at Heritage Village. The use of designs from LEGO®kits are not permitted.
- 4. All entries must be built by the participant(s) listed on the entry form. Entries built by two or more individuals will be judged in the category of the oldest participant.
- 5. An entry form must be submitted for each original LEGO[™] creation. Forms may be found on the Heritage Village website or picked up in the Heritage Village gift shop.
- 6. Entries must be submitted for judging by February 10, 2026. Participants will be informed of acceptance by February 28, 2026.
- 7. All entries will be submitted via entry forms, images, description, and dimensions are required.
- 8. Winning projects must be delivered to Heritage Village at 11909 125th Street N., Largo, FL 33774 for exhibition in Roy Helms until the end of 2026.
- 9. Contestants must take their entries home at the close of the exhibition. LEGOS®not taken home become property of Heritage Village.

Entries will be judged by Heritage Village staff. Winners are selected based on their total score from the following areas:

- 1. Design 25 points (Construction is recognizable, and fits the theme)
- 2. Originality 25 points (Design is their own vs. a kit)
- 3. Written Description 15 points (Written content is creative and descriptive)
- 4. Degree of Difficulty 35 points (Contains many elements and visual details)
